

Attitudes of Visually Impaired and their Parents towards the mainstream program into regular schools in Gaza Governorate

Abstract : This study aims at realizing the attitudes of Visually Impaired and their parents towards the mainstream program into regular school in Gaza Governorate.

Two scales were adopted to measure attitudes, one was designed for the Visually Impaired pupil, the other was designed their parents.

The sample of study consists of 80 pupils and their parents. Results showed positive attitudes of Visually Impaired towards mainstreaming, whereas the attitudes of their parents were not satisfied.

Results also showed the positive attitudes of males within the sample more than those of female and the attitudes of Visually Impaired pupils in both governmental and UN schools has the same attitudes.

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
